Essay Prompts—Highlight the one you will answer:			
<b>Category</b> : Analyze an writer's use of imagery, language, stylistic devices, and universal themes to show how his work reflects the major characteristics of the literary movement to which it belongs. **You may show how a <u>contemporary</u> work reflects one of the movements. ( <i>Writing Application Standard</i> 2.2 b & d)			
<b>Theme</b> : Analyze the way in which the theme or meaning of a work represents a view or comment on life. ( <i>Literary Response and Analysis Standard 3.2</i> )			
<b>Aesthetics</b> : Analyze the ways in which irony, tone, mood, the writer's style, and/or the "sound" of language achieve specific rhetorical or aesthetic purposes or both. ( <i>Literary Response and Analysis Standard 3.3</i> ) You can answer this by stating which literary movement is the best in allure and beauty. Then use one or two works within that movement to prove your position.			
<b>Tone</b> : Analyze ways in which a writer uses imagery, figures of speech, and sounds to evoke readers' emotions. ( <i>Literary Response and Analysis Standard 3.4</i> ) This would work well if you want to show how a romantic work evokes feelings of "the sublime" or melancholy; or how a transcendental work evokes optimism.			
<b>Historical</b> : Evaluate the philosophical, political, religious, ethical, and social influences of the historical period that shaped the characters, plots, and settings. ( <i>Literary Response and Analysis Standard</i> 3.5 c). For example how American expansionism, industrialization, and manifest destiny might have influenced Henry David Thoreau to write <i>Walden, or Life in the Woods</i> or "Resistance to Civil Government."
